

## **Fact Sheet: Transportation**

Here are a few transportation-related improvements that were made to make it easier to get to Tsawwassen Mills.

### **Road Improvements**

Significant upgrades to the road network have been made to improve traffic flow and vehicle access to Tsawwassen Mills, including:

- The widening of Highway 17 to three lanes in both directions, from east of 56<sup>th</sup> to Tsawwassen Drive;
- Improvements to the Highway 17 intersections at Salish Sea Drive and 56<sup>th</sup>;
- Many new roads were constructed on TFN land for the benefit of the entire community. Salish Sea Drive, Canoe Pass Way and Fisherman Way were all constructed to provide access to and from the shopping centres and provide new linkages in and out of the community;
- The closure of the current Tsawwassen Drive to traffic north of Highway 17;
- Improvements to the 41B / Deltaport interchange;
- The Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure have timed the traffic signals on Highway 17 to accommodate and facilitate ferry traffic.

### **Public Transit**

Translink has implemented bus service changes to provide service to Tsawwassen Mills including:

- The **601 South Delta/Boundary Bay/Bridgeport Station** reroutes to Tsawwassen via 52<sup>nd</sup> Street to connect directly to Tsawwassen Mills. An additional northbound trip has been added at 8:11 a.m. at 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue/52A Street in Boundary Bay;
- The **609 Tsawwassen First Nation/South Delta Exchange** reroutes via Canoe Pass Way, Salish Sea Drive and Blue Heron Drive to provide direct access to Tsawwassen Mills. This new service starts on Oct. 5;
- The **620 Tsawwassen Ferry/Bridgeport Station route** added a new stop at 52<sup>nd</sup> Street, near Bass Pro Shops.

### **Free Tsawwassen Ferry Shuttle**

A complimentary shuttle service is available between Tsawwassen Mills and Tsawwassen Ferry Terminal in coordination with ferry schedules.

### **Employee Shuttle**

An employee bus service is available between the Scott Road Skytrain Station in Surrey and the shopping centre.


